# Michigan 21st Century Community Learning Centers 2021–22 Program Highlights

Michigan's 21st Century Community Learning Centers (CCLC) program offers academic enrichment to students in high-poverty and low-performing schools. During the 2021-22 program year, there were 12 school-based agencies and 12 community-based organizations working as grantees to manage 250 sites and served over 15,000 school-aged youth. All Michigan 21st CCLC sites provided both afterschool and summer programming across Michigan.

## **Student Data**

Enrollment in 2021–2022 recovered somewhat from the previous year but did not reach pre-pandemic levels. Of the 15,536 students in Michigan 21st CCLC programs, 85% were economically disadvantaged and 86% were academically low-performing.

Figure 1. Student Race/Ethnicity





Figure 2. Student Grade Level

## **Activities**

**97%** of students participated in at least one academic activity for more than 15 hours, including homework help and academic enrichment activities. More than half of high school students (55%) participated in credit recovery sessions.



## **Academic Outcomes**

Among academically low-performing students, 43% improved their grades.


